Governing and Process WASP Distinguished Guest Professors The WASP Distinguished Guest Professors program is governed by the following:

- There will be two annual guest professorships at the highest international scientific level
- The program includes all the scientific areas within WASP
- Nominations must be balanced (50/50) for gender equality
- The distribution of time periods for physical attendance at a WASP University and the duration of the guest professorship is flexible.
- The minimum duration for the guest professorship is six months.

The nomination process is according to the following:

- Nomination of candidates during Q4 each year
- The University Representative Group (URG) presents a joint list of nominates that is 50/50 balanced.
- The Research Management Group (RMG) evaluates the nominated candidates and makes a recommendation to the WASP board.
- A decision is made by the WASP board at a board meeting either in Q1 or Q2.
- The universities concerned recruit their candidate for start at the earliest in Q3.
