

PROGRAM CLARIFICATION

The Wallenberg AI, Autonomous Systems and Software Program (WASP) is Sweden's single largest research initiative ever, funded by the Knut and Alice Wallenberg Foundation and launched in 2015. It is operated with support from participating industries and WASP's partner universities: Chalmers University of Technology, KTH Royal Institute of Technology, Linköping University, Lund University and Umeå University, and Affiliated Groups of Excellence at Luleå University of Technology, Uppsala University and Örebro University.

The program includes a doctoral graduate school that provides advanced skills to analyze, develop, and contribute to the interdisciplinary area of artificial intelligence, autonomous systems and software. This is achieved through an ambitious program with customized graduate school courses at the partner universities, international research visits, and visiting lecturers – all in close collaboration with Swedish industry. The WASP Graduate School forms a strong multidisciplinary and international professional network joining doctoral students, researchers and industry.

The WASP Graduate School gives added value to existing doctoral studies at the partner universities, by providing unique opportunities for students who are dedicated to achieving international research excellence with industrial relevance.
