Purpose of this document

At the end of each year, each active arena should make a yearly report describing how the initiative has fulfilled the approved program. The report should describe the status and achievements of the current activity year, including KPIs and how the funding has been utilized. The reports from all arenas will be reviewed at the same occasion by the Arena Management Group (AMG). The outcome of the review will be presented to the Executive Committee before it is considered by the board for a decision.
